The AGS Board of Directors is recommending the flowing changes to the by-laws. These changes are to define the calculation of annual dues and special assessments when Associate Members are voted as Regular members.

Underline denote ADDITIONS

Bold Red denotes DELETIONS

Article III – MEMBERSHIP

Paragraph B

New Members - Prospective new members become Associate Members for six (6) months by paying one half (1/2) of the annual dues **and the full amount of any Special Assessment (see Article IX), if required**. Associate Members have all rights and duties of Regular Members except voting rights. During the seventh month, the membership shall be discussed and voted upon by secret ballot. <u>Upon notification of</u> <u>having been approved the new Regular Member must pay all</u> <u>dues and required special assessments prorated from the</u> <u>month of approval to the end of the current dues year</u>.

Article IX – DUES, FEE and ASSESSMENTS Paragraph J

Special assessments will not be levied on <u>Associate</u>, Student and Family Members.

The new dues rates for 2014-2015 are Regular = \$125.00, Senior = \$112.50, Family = \$5.00, Student = \$20 and Flying

controller and battery size / capacity. The sweet spot for most sport pilots is 100 watts per pound of aircraft flying

weight.


New Years Day Fun Fly
