The AGS Board of Directors is recommending the flowing changes to the by-laws. These changes are to define the calculation of annual dues and special assessments when Associate Members are voted as Regular members.

Underline denote ADDITIONS

Bold Red denotes DELETIONS

Article III – MEMBERSHIP

Paragraph B

New Members - Prospective new members become Associate Members for six (6) months by paying one half (1/2) of the annual dues and the full amount of any Special Assessment (see Article IX), if required. Associate Members have all rights and duties of Regular Members except voting rights. During the seventh month, the membership shall be discussed and voted upon by secret ballot. Upon notification of having been approved the new Regular Member must pay all dues and required special assessments prorated from the month of approval to the end of the current dues year.

Article IX – DUES, FEE and ASSESSMENTS
Paragraph J

Special assessments will not be levied on <u>Associate</u>, Student and Family Members.

The AGS has purchased insurance for the BC United field for the entire year 2015. Contact Rick if you are interested in

organizing a group fly at the BC field.

Ray Phillips read the board recommended by-law changes. These changes were discussed, motion made and approved.

Ray Phillips reviewed the AGS 2014-2015 budget. After some discussion, the budget was approved by a vote of Yes-16,

No-0 and A-1.

The new dues rates for 2014-2015 are Regular = \$125.00, Senior = \$112.50, Family = \$5.00, Student = \$20 and Flying Event Fee of \$5 per pilot. Member must become dues current on or before the 2 April 2015 meeting.

Bob Frey displayed his new E-Flite B17 model. Now we need a few micro P-51 aircraft to escort Bob on his missions.

Harold Peeling brought an electric powered glider from Esprit. Harold has been very impressed with this models

performance and handing characteristics.

Charlie Hatton flew his new very low cost micro quad. This small aircraft is very quick. Finding the missing micro props

can be very challenging.

Jeff Hatton gave a presentation on sizing electric flight systems. He gave tips on selecting the correct motor, motor

controller and battery size / capacity. The sweet spot for most sport pilots is 100 watts per pound of aircraft flying

weight.

FLIGHT TRIMMING OF MODEL AIRCRAFT: Bob Noll

This check list for flight trimming models is based on an article by the late Jim Kirkland in Model Airplane News several years ago. Save this list for reference when flight trimming your planes.

FLIGHT TRIM

Jim Kirkland/Bob Noll

1. Hands off, upright flight Full power

Adjust elevator and aileron

2. Inverted straight flight

Full power

If plane turns, adjust rudder same direction as turn

Readjust aileron

Repeat a and b

3. Trim for glide

Full power upright

Cut power

If plane balloons, add up thrust

If plane dives, add down thrust

If much elevator required in glide, check C.G. and wing incidence

Set control surface deflections

Elevator - set for reliable spin

Rudder - set for stall turn

Aileron - set for three rolls in four seconds

Aileron differential

Do split S from long climb (180 degree roll to left)

If heading at bottom is left, too much differential

Loop tracking

Do loops away from pilot

One inside loop - look for heavy wing panel

One outside loop - " #

Heading changes

If at beginning of loop, adjust rudder, readjust aileron

If at top of loop, adjust engine thrust

If inside loops are good, but not outside loops, raise both ailerons
