Meeting Minutes:

Jerry Wright made a motion to approve the minutes of Meeting #860 (August 5, 2019) as published in The Connector. Bill Murray seconded the motion. Motion was approved.

Treasurer Report:

Brent Bryson gave the financial report. If any member has any questions regarding our account, they can contact Brent Bryson for additional information.

Social Membership:

Rick Allabaugh stated that there were some issues with the proposed Social Membership Bylaws Change as presented in the Connector and therefore it would not be voted on at this meeting. These issues will need to be addressed before the change can be presented to the membership. A discussion ensued on the definition of a Social Member.

2019-2020 Budget:

Rick Allabaugh discussed the two Budget options as presented in the Connector. After some discussion Jerry Wright made a motion to adopt the budget option setting Regular Member dues at \$125 and Senior Member dues at \$112.50. David Dewey-Wright seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Officer Candidates:

Ray Phillips discussed the status of a testing requirement that may be eventually imposed on all R/C model pilots by the FAA. At the present nothing has been set up.

Ray Phillips reported that there were twelve participants with twenty-five planes. The first entrant was from West Virginia and won the "Theme Plane" award and won a raffle prize.

First up is a Bridi Kaos 60 almost ready for paint. I say almost but the truth is once a model is to this stage its only half finished and there's still much to be done. Over the years I have had 60 size Super Kaos, Utter Kaos, Killer Kaos and Ultimate Kaos, but never the original 1970 Kaos...until now. This one will use a NIB

1974 OS Max 60FSR and JR radio equipment.



For my winter build I have selected a 1968 kit designed by Nick Ziroli, the Moraine Saulnier. This is a stand

way off scale model of a French WW1 aircraft, and was

a very popular model at the Rhinebeck WW1 Jamboree

in its day. Label states use a .19 for Galloping Ghost, .35
