Brent Bryson called the meeting to order at 6:43 PM.

Treasurer's report:

Jeff. H. presented the treasurer's report.

Previous Minutes:

Brent read the minutes from the previous general meeting. Bob Jennings replied that the previous minutes needed to be amended, stating the actual vote to have Edward Bennett be the new Secretary be added to the previous minutes. Jeff motioned for an amendment to the previous minutes and David seconded that motion. The motion was accepted. The previous minutes will be amended to include the vote and approval of Edward Bennett, who was elected as the new Secretary. Edward read aloud the previous board minutes.

Old Business:

Brent confirmed that the solar panel installation at the AGS field was no longer an option. The actual cost of the installation of the connection to the grid would be cost-prohibitive for Nexamp.

New Business:

Jeff discussed the potential for the AGS to reincorporate into a 501C3. The members discussed and wanted to know more about the cost, structure, and potential benefits. Ed is currently researching the approximate cost of

attorney's fees. Once the fees are confirmed, they will be a topic of discussion. Jeff brought up the potential for a storage option at the AGS field such as shipping containers and how much revenue rental fees for a 40-high cube container could yield AGS. The actual cost, maintenance, and installation were also discussed. Jeff and Ed will continue to research the cost of a container. Bill gave us an update on the Ford tractor. Bill installed a new tune-up kit and replaced a broken pipe on the tractor. Todd did a test run on the tractor, mowing for an hour. The tractor is running fine without any issues.
